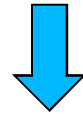

COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING DECISION

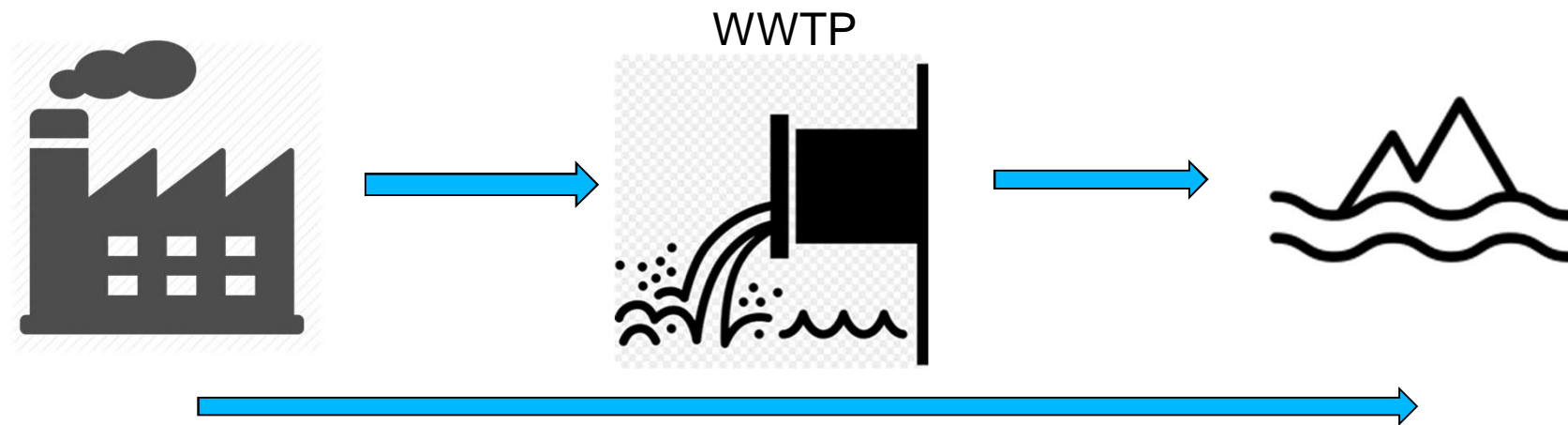
